**CIVIC ACTION PROGRAMMES ORGANISED BY BSF**

On 09 Nov 2018, BSF organised Civic Action Programme at two different bordering locations with the objective of extending a friendly and helping hand to the local people to attain better level of living. Civic Action programmes are the direct way for giving BSF an opportunity to serve border population while urging the BSF officials to liaise with the local administration to determine and fulfil the needs of the local people. BSF is determined to continue the endeavour to fulfil the need of the local people and always stand for the wellness of bordering people.

The first programme organised from 03:00 PM to 04:20 PM, in area of responsibility of BOP Pratap, 133 Bn BSF, at village-Sagarpara, under PS – Wangmun, District – Tripura (North), in presence of Shri Ashok Kumar, Commandant, 133 Bn BSF alongwith 01 Officer and village Sagarpara Gram Pradhan. A total of 35 civilians including 20 male and 15 female attended the programme, during which, following items costing a total of Rs.2,18,000/-, were distributed to civilians :- Sintex 500 ltrs – 08 Nos, Sintex 1000 ltrs - 02 Nos, Suction pipe - 100 mtrs, Water Filters - 40 Nos, Carom Boards - 03 Nos, Volley balls - 03 Nos, Solar lights - 04 Sets.

Another Civic action programme was organised in area of responsibility of BOP Jamanipara, 133 Bn BSF at village-Kolarampara, under PS-Wangmun, District – Tripura (North), in presence of Commandant, 133 Bn BSF along with Gram Pradhan. Male -20 and female – 25, total of 45 civilians attended the said programme. Various items including Sintex(500 ltrs), Sintex (1000 ltrs), Suction Pipe, Water filters cemented, Carrom Boards, Volley balls and Solar lights, total costing Rs.1,80,000/- distributed among the civilians.

Gram Pradhan of the villages appreciated and expressed his thanks to BSF on organising such programme. Both the functions concluded with warm greetings from civilians to BSF and a photo session.
