BSF CONDUCTED DRIVING TRAINING FOR DEVELOPING SKILLS IN BORDER
YOUTHS

On 13th Nov, 2018, a Civic Action Programme organised at Community Hall, Kathalcheri, under PS- Sabroom, District – South Tripura, in area or responsibility of 66 Bn BSF. The Civic Action Programme was organised on the occasion of completion of one month motor driving training, conducted by the selected able driving instructors of BSF from 10th Sept 2018 to 10th Oct 2018 in co-operation with Saifaly Motor Driving Training School, Sabroom. The training was conducted for youths of the bordering area, to make them aware with traffic rules and regulations and add to their job skills. During the training, total 11 trainees successfully qualified the driving tests.

The Civic Action cum Training Programme was organised under the leadership of Shri Dinesh Kumar, Commandant, 66 Bn BSF. On completion of training ceremony was organised in the presence of Shri H K Lohia, IPS, IG BSF Tripura Frontier as Chief guest.
